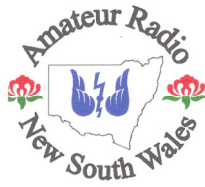

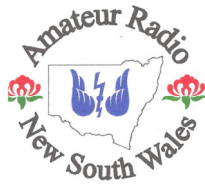

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NOTICE TO CANDIDATES - 2024

Nominations for election to the Board close at 10am on Saturday 2nd March 2024. Nominations are to be returned to the Secretary, care of the Office. Nominations must be in writing (58a). If sending by mail they must arrive in the Post Office box, no later than Friday 1st March 2024.

Candidate: The nominee must be a financial Ordinary, or Honorary Life Members, for a period of three (3) current and consecutive years at the close of nominations (58b). Associate members are those who do not hold an appropriate "Certificate of Proficiency" and are ineligible to be nominated to the Board (14).

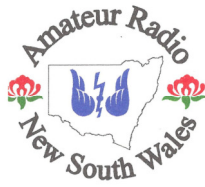
Proposer & Seconder: At the close of nominations the proposer and seconder must be financial and have a minimum of three (3) current and consecutive years of membership of ARNSW (58d). It is the responsibility of the candidate to find their own proposer and seconder, and to assure that they are Ordinary, or Honorary Life Members.

Resume: With the ballot papers, candidate resumes will be sent out to members. The resumes are to be a maximum of 200 words and are to be forwarded to the Secretary, within three days after the close of nominations (Tuesday 5th March 2024). The resumes can be forwarded to the Office by post or by e-mail to elections@arnsw.org.au. The Secretary reserves the right to edit any resumes over 200 words.

Scrutineer: Each candidate is entitled to appoint a scrutineer to observe the count of ballots. The count will take place in the afternoon (time to be determined) of Friday 12th April 2024 at 63 Quarry Road Dural. Any candidates, who want to appoint a scrutineer, but are unable to find one, should contact the returning officer and he may be able to assist by suggesting a few names.

Director ID Number: It is a requirement of the Corporations Act that all company directors must have a Director ID prior to being appointed to the Board. You can apply online, free of charge, at <https://www.abrs.gov.au/director-identification-number/about-director-id>.
